The Farm Park Supervisor will report to the Farm Park & Play Manager having supervisory responsibility for the Occombe Farm animal attraction facilities including the Animal Encounters Barn and the Animal Paddocks, overseeing all operational and people supervision.

As Farm Park Supervisor you will be responsible for:

- Day to day operations of the animal attraction facility
- Line management of Farm Park Assistants, including operational supervision, training/development/coaching in animal welfare and husbandry knowledge
- Rota management, ensuring appropriate staffing levels at all times
- Guest satisfaction, delivering first class customer service through appropriate engagement and interpretation
- Responsibility for animal feeding
- Responsibility for cleaning of animal enclosures and wider visitor area within the animal centre
- Health and safety responsibilities in relation to animal welfare and biosecurity, visitor hygiene and first aid
- Visitor capacity management
- Duty management responsibilities
- Collaborative working with other areas of the business for event planning

- Supervising the animal attraction element of children's birthday parties
- Deputising for the Farm Park & Play Manager as required, including KPI reporting
